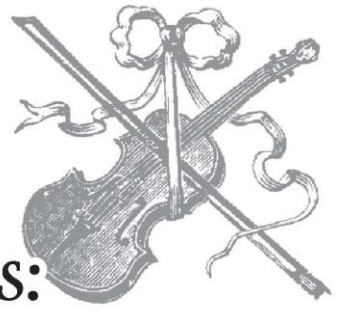

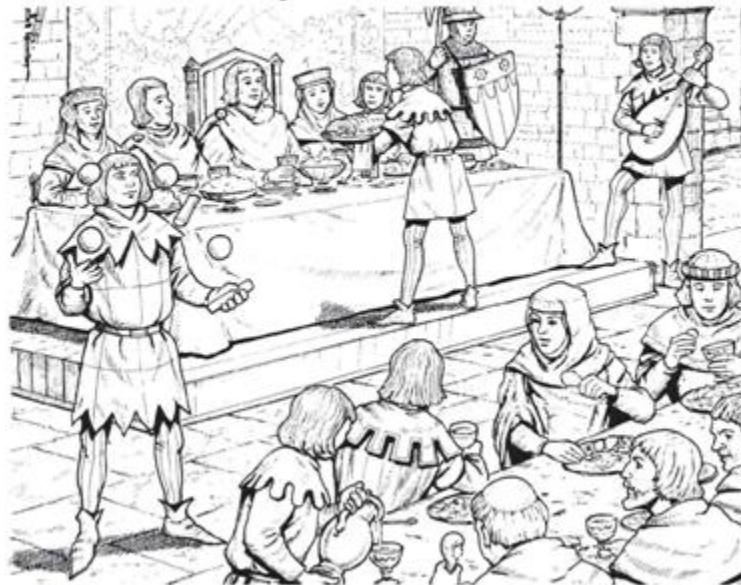
2010-2011 Series Presents:
